Called by Jesus Christ to Follow Him

Underline the words that catch how the Lord has been making Himself known to you.

“And to another He said, ‘Follow me.’” Lk 9:59 “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.” Mt 11:28 “Neither do I condemn you. Go; from now on do not sin anymore.” John 8:11 “As you go, make this proclamation: ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’” Mt 10:7 “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Mt 28:19 “My Father is glorified when you become my disciples; that is, when you bear much fruit.” Jn 15:8 “That they may all be one... that the world may believe.” John 17:21

Jesus is the Way – leading us into hope; the Truth – lighting up our confusion; and the Life – restoring our joy through loving forgiveness of our sins. Jn 14:6 “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word and my Father will love him; and we will come to him and make our **home** with him.” Jn 14:23 Jesus **forgives sins** Mk 2:5 and **judges** the world. Mt 25:31-46

He is the **Messiah** and the **Son** of God, Mk 14:61-62 and **God** the Son. Jn 8:58 When we **open** the door to Him, He has **supper with us**. Rev 3:20 His **teaching** describes what He is like **himself**, and what **He calls us to become**: Mt 5-7 His works manifested the **power** of God Jn 10:37-38 and He promised that, since they believe in Him, his **disciples will do the same** and even greater works. Jn 14:12

Jesus fulfilled what God foretold by the prophets. He conquered death for all who believe, He continues to **love, care for, and lead us**, and the **outpouring of the Holy Spirit** is Jesus’ greatest work with his Father, and it draws us into a **life very much like his own**. It is this life which makes up the Church – the **living Assembly** of all who believe in Him and follow Him. Heb. 10:25
