(3:1-9)

(PAUSE)

The souls of the righteous are in the hands of God,
and no torment will ever touch them.

In the eyes of the foolish they seemed to have died,
and their departure was thought to be a disaster,
and their going from us to be their destruction;
but they are at peace.

For though in the sight of others they were punished,
their hope is full of immortality.

Having been disciplined a little,
they will receive great good,
because God tested them and found them worthy of himself;
like gold in the furnace he tried them,
and like a sacrificial burnt offering he accepted them.

In the time of their visitation they will shine forth,
and will run like sparks through the stubble.

They will govern nations and rule over peoples,
and the Lord will reign over them forever.

Those who trust in him will understand truth,
and the faithful will abide with him in love,
because grace and mercy are upon his holy ones,
and he watches over his elect.

Responsorial psalm (Psalm 116 -- an Alleluia psalm)

Reader: Our response to the Word of the Lord is –

R I will walk in the presence of the Lord in the land of the living.

(Allow the assembly to repeat the response, but you don't repeat it; then proceed.)

Reader:

Gracious is the Lord, and righteous;
our God is merciful.

The Lord protects the simple;
when I was brought low, he saved me. **(Response)**

I kept my faith, even when I said,
"I am greatly afflicted";
I said in my consternation,
"Everyone is a liar." **(Response)**

Precious in the sight of the Lord
is the death of his faithful ones.
O Lord, I am your servant;
You have loosed my bonds. **(Response)**

(2 CORINTHIENS 4, 14 — 5, 1)

(PAUSE)

Frères,

4 ¹⁴ nous le savons, celui qui a ressuscité le Seigneur Jésus
nous ressuscitera, nous aussi, avec Jésus,
et il nous placera près de lui avec vous.

15 Et tout ce qui nous arrive, c'est pour vous,
afin que la grâce plus abondante,
en vous rendant plus nombreux,
fasse monter une immense action de grâce
pour la gloire de Dieu.

16 C'est pourquoi nous ne perdons pas courage,
et même si en nous l'homme extérieur va vers sa ruine,

(25:31-46)

(PAUSE)

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him,
then he will sit on the throne of his glory.

All the nations will be gathered before him,
and he will separate people one from another
as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats,
and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left.

Then the king will say to those at his right hand,
"Come, you that are blessed by my Father,
inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world;
for I was hungry and you gave me food,
I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink,
I was a stranger and you welcomed me,
I was naked and you gave me clothing,
I was sick and you took care of me,
I was in prison and you visited me.'

Then the righteous will answer him,
"Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food,
or thirsty and gave you something to drink?
And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you,
or naked and gave you clothing?
And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?'

And the king will answer them,
"Truly I tell you,
just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family,
you did it to me.'
