**RITE OF EUCHARISTIC ADORATION – EXPOSITION AND BENEDICTION**

**Fatima Angel's Prayer** “O Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences by which He is offended. By the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary I beg the conversion of poor sinners.”

**Fatima Pardon Prayer** “My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I beg pardon for all those that do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee.”

**Fatima Decade Prayer** (*at the end of each decade of the Rosary*) “O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy mercy. Amen.”

**Prayer to evangelize our world in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Millennium with Jesus Eucharist**

God our Father, we bless you and give you thanks for your Son Jesus, gift of your love for the life of the world. Watch over your Church as in faith she lives and proclaims with joy and hope the Good News for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Millennium. Renew our faith in the Holy Eucharist, the memorial of your Son's death and resurrection. Nourish us with your Word, Jesus our Bread of Life; so that united with Mary, the Mother of your Divine Son and Mother of the Church, we will bear much fruit for the salvation of the world. Holy Spirit, shed your light upon us and grant us strength to serve as faithful witnesses to the Gospel. We ask all this through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
