

How to Prepare for Confirmation – Candidate & Sponsor

How you and your sponsor can prepare for your confirmation:

1. Attend Sunday Mass every Sunday
2. Ask to see a priest and have a good confession - the sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation
3. Pray every day, such as in the morning and evening:
 - (1) Read a few Psalms in the Book of Psalms in the Bible - these are inspired prayers and very enlightening - skim through them and find a few that catch your eye.
 - (2) make silence within you, giving God a chance to touch your mind and heart
 - (3) you can also let the prayers of the Rosary help you meditate and ponder the mysteries of the Rosary
4. Make peace with anyone with whom you have differences, to the extent the other is willing. If not, pray for that person, as Jesus asked us to do.
5. Read up a little and reflect on the role of Confirmation in our relationship with God, others, our own life, and the world:

I will have to prepare myself 15 minutes before Mass; so I will have to begin with you 30 minutes before Mass. If you're not there, you will miss it.
